Adult Adipose Derived Stem Cells are the body's natural healing cells - they are recruited by chemical signals emitted by damaged tissues to repair and regenerate the body's damaged cells. The Irvine Stem Cell Treatment Center only uses autologous stem cells from a person's own fat – no embryonic stem cells are used. Our current areas of study include: Heart Failure (CHF), Emphysema, COPD, Chronic Bronchitis, Asthma, Parkinson's Disease, Stroke, Multiple Sclerosis, Lupus (SLE), Crohn's, Auto-immune Disorders and orthopedic joint injections (Knee, Shoulder, Hip, etc.).

Dr. Thomas A. Gionis will address IRB approved protocols and investigational use of Autologous Adult Adipose Derived Stem Cells (ADSC's) for clinical research and deployment for numerous cardiovascular disorders.

Dr. Thomas A. Gionis serves as the Surgeon-in-Chief of the Irvine Stem Cell Treatment Center, Miami Stem Cell Treatment Center and the New York Stem Cell Treatment Center. Dr. Gionis has been a practicing physician and surgeon for 40 years. He is recognized as the youngest individual in the United States to have obtained his MD degree. After completing high school at 16, Dr. Gionis started medical school at 17 years of age (having completed 3 ½ years of college in one year), and obtained his M.D. medical degree at 21. Dr. Gionis is a Physician, Attorney, Public Health specialist, and United States Fulbright Scholar in Law, and frequent Invited lecturer, world-wide, for seminars and conferences sponsored by the United Nations UNESCO organization. Dr. Gionis serves as President and Chairman of the Board, of the American Board of Stem Cell Medicine and Surgery (www.ABSCMS.org) and of the Fulbright Academy of Law, Peace and Public Health (Washington, DC) (www.FulbrightAcademyLaw.org); and also serves as United States Fulbright PEER Review Committee – Global / Public Health. He has served twice as UCLA Visiting Scholar in Public Health, UCLA School of Public Health; and has held positions such as Clinical Professor of Surgery, Western University of Health Sciences (Los Angeles, California); and Adjunct Professor of Law, Thomas Jefferson School of Law International Tax Program (San Diego, California). Dr. Gionis has been recognized as a Fellow, American College of Legal Medicine; Fellow, American Institute for Healthcare Quality; and Fellow, International College of Surgeons. Dr. Gionis completed his Research Fellowship at the Harvard Massachusetts General Hospital (MGH).
