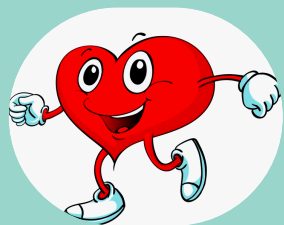

Bill began his career in emergency services as a paramedic for the City of Santa Ana, serving from 1978 to 1983 while completing his undergraduate degree at Cal State University, Long Beach, in Health Science. While doing graduate studies in Sports Medicine and Exercise Physiology, Bill was accepted to the PA Program at the USC School of Medicine, at which time he left Santa Ana Fire.

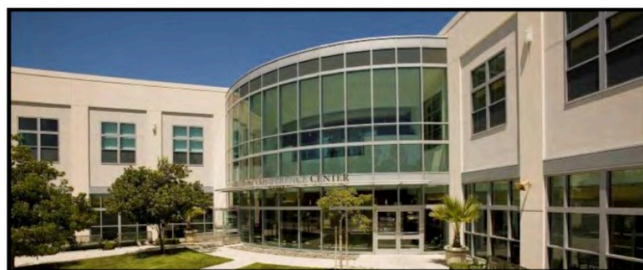
Upon completion of PA school, Bill worked at the Student Health Center at the University of California, Irvine before accepting a position as a Health Services Practitioner in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, where he worked for two years. Following his time in Saudi, Bill completed a residency in Emergency Medicine at L.A. County, U.S.C. Medical Center.

Upon completion of his PA residency in 1989, Bill began his career with Orange County Fire. Bill worked as a firefighter paramedic before promoting to captain in 1999, battalion chief in 2011, and division chief this year.
